Prom Policy & Dress Code

We are working to make this year's prom a special and memorable experience for our students. As a Christian organization partnering with others in our community, we value creating meaningful opportunities for like-minded students.

To clearly communicate expectations for attire and safety, please review the following guidelines for students and their guests.

Blue Springs Enrichment's Homeschool Prom will be held on Friday, April 10, 2026, from 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM at Bar R Ranch, 5657 Reddoch Road, Marianna, FL 32446. **BSE students and their guests must follow all guidelines in this document. By purchasing a ticket, the student and parent/guardian confirm they have read, understand, and agree to abide by the following policies.**

1. All attendees that are not BSE students must present a copy of their current school ID, birth certificate, or driver's license at the door. No admittance without an ID.
2. All non-BSE students/attendees must submit a copy of their ID to Bonnie Simpson by April 1, 2026. Only students who are on the approved list will be admitted. No exchange of tickets allowed. **No guests over the age of 21 will be admitted.**
3. There is no re-entry. Once students or guests leave, they may not return.
4. Students who are dressed inappropriately will not be admitted to prom and no refunds will be issued. Anyone deemed inappropriate by administrators on duty will be denied admittance.
5. Backpacks or large purses are not permitted.
6. Students are required to always demonstrate appropriate behavior while in attendance at prom, both on the dance floor and the designated areas.
7. Students are to refrain from physical contact or dance styles that are sexually explicit in nature. **(Administration has the final decision.)**
8. Students who do not abide by these standards will be asked to leave the prom and **no refund will be given.** Parents/guardians will be contacted regarding their dismissal from the event.
9. Students attending prom must meet the following discipline eligibility requirements:
 - a. Misconduct at a school sponsored activity
 - i. If a student is suspended for possession, consumption, and/or being under the influence of alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance at a school-sponsored activity, s/he will not be permitted to attend Prom.
 - b. Disciplinary eligibility
 - i. If the student has received an Incident report with *excessive disruptive behavior*.
 - ii. If the student has been expelled from current school.
10. Students and guests who are suspected of alcohol or drug consumption or possession, weapon possession other violations will be: **a.** Detained, and a parent or guardian contacted; **b.** Removed from the prom; **c.** Restricted from other future BSE sponsored events; *i.* Graduating seniors will lose the privilege of participating in the commencement ceremony and remaining senior activities. *ii.* BSE underclassmen will lose the privilege of attending any school-sponsored events for one calendar year. **d.** Police officers will be contacted.

DRESS CODE

Female Attendees

Formal gowns or pantsuits. Strapless is not permitted.

Dresses are to be no more than 2 inches above the knee (front and back). This also applies to slits in dresses.

The front of the dress must not fall below the bra line.

The back of the dress must not fall below the waist.

Male Attendees

Males are encouraged to wear a suit, tux or sports coat, but at a minimum, they are expected to wear semiformal wear, such as slacks, nice shoes, and a nice shirt.

Ties are encouraged, but not required.

The following will not be permitted:

Dresses with revealing cut-outs.

See-through gowns, including sheer/mesh overlays that do not have material underneath.

Shorts

Torn clothing

All Students

If the attire is questionable, students are encouraged to show their evening wear to an administrator beforehand to determine if it is dance appropriate.

Non-compliant students will not be admitted to the dance. No refunds will be given for dance dress code infractions.

I understand the Prom is a BSE-sponsored event and a privilege. I have read and understand the Prom Policy & Dress Code and agree to abide to by all terms. If I fail to comply by these rules, I understand that I may be removed from Prom, be restricted from participating in any future BSE sponsored events, including but not limited to losing the privilege of participating in the commencement ceremony and/or face charges from law enforcement.
